

## Recital Week - Dress Rehearsal/Show Day Procedures

- **Date:** Thursday, June 6th
- **Location:** ARC Center, 201 W. National St., West Chicago, IL
- **Tickets:**
  - Guardians should receive their 2 complimentary tickets the Monday of show week via email.
  - Anyone who purchased recital tickets will also receive their tickets the Monday of show week via email.
  - Children under 2 years of age do not need a ticket.
  - Backstage volunteers do not need a ticket.
  - Any extra family members/friends can purchase tickets the day of the show for \$10 CASH ONLY.
  - We will also be selling some fun recital gifts (squishmellows, wooden rose bouquets, printed programs, etc.) - CASH ONLY!
  
- **Arrival:**
  - Review your dancer's class call time.
  - Doors open for audience members at 6:00 PM and the show starts promptly at 6:15 PM.
  - Dancers must arrive in **full costume, hair and make-up with proper tights and footwear READY TO BE ON STAGE** at their class call time. There will **not** be an area to change when your dancer arrives. Dancers with multiple costume changes will be allowed to use the dressing room area. Dancers are welcome to bring a water bottle, but do not need to bring anything else with them. Please do not pack your dancer with food, electronics, etc.
  - Upon arrival, 1 guardian will escort the dancer to their assigned dressing room. They will find their class volunteer (they will be wearing a Hawaiian lei) and sign-in with them. After their dancer is checked in, guardians may leave.
  - Dancers will then head into the performance space for their 10 minute rehearsal block to practice and record their routine with the videographer. Only dancers and instructors will be allowed into the performance space at that time.

- At the end of the rehearsal time block, audience members will find their assigned seats and watch all classes perform in the show.
- Dancers are required to stay for the entire performance time. Dancers will sit on the floor with their class volunteer during the show.
- For safety dancers will not be allowed to sign out until the end of the show.
- Dismissal:
  - 1 guardian can pick up their dancer from their class volunteer after the show. Guardians will be required to sign out their dancers with the class volunteer.
  - Other family members should move to the lobby area to wait for their dancer once the show is finished.
